The Story

Parents: Review this lesson with your child.

As the disciples were with Jesus one day, they started arguing. They wanted to know who was the most important. Jesus knew what they were thinking.

The disciples asked him, "Who is best in heaven?"

Then Jesus picked up a little child. He said, "Become like children, or you will never go to heaven. Whoever is like a little child is best in heaven. Treat little children like you treat me. The smallest are the greatest to me.

Whoever tricks a little one to sin has sinned so badly that it would be better if a big rock was tied around him and he was thrown into the river to drown.

Another time, babies were brought to Jesus. The disciples told them the people with the babies to go away.

Jesus didn't like what He saw. He said, "I want little children to come to Me. Do not make them go away. The kingdom of heaven is made for them too. Older people should believe like little children do." Then He touched the little children and blessed them.




Thank You, God, for giving me Your Word, the Bible. Thank You, Jesus, for taking all my sins away and making me one of Your children. Amen.
